Special Conditions:

1. The Finals will run under special rules.
2. Random (MCP) Tests and/or Veterinary Examination maybe made at any time, see NF Rules Art. 120. Horses competing in the championship must bring Horse Passport.
3. QUALIFICATION CRITERIA
 - Children, Junior & Young Rider – All Qualified
 - Division 1 – All Qualified
 - Division 2 – All Athletes who have points.
 - Novice - All Athletes who have points.
 - Top 10 from the Emirates Championship for all categories.

4. 1 horse per category. Division 1 and Young rider, **Division 2 and Junior (2 horse per rider)**
5. Rider may change the horse for any reason before one hour of first class start.
6. Entry Fee of AED 300 for (D1,JR,YR & D2), AED 200 for (CH/NV) per category per horse will be collected + VAT. All competing horses will be allocated a show ID no by the OC which has to visibly displayed on horses all times. No horse allowed inside the warmup arena without the number.
7. Riders have to start in all their classes to be eligible for prize money.
8. Longines Wild Card (2023-2024 season): The winning combination (Horse/Rider) of each category will be rewarded with a Longines Wild Card will reward them with free entries to all the National & International Showjumping events taking place during the Emirates Longines League for the 2023-2024 season. This wild card is not transferable to another rider or another horse.

CHILDREN

DAY 1	The competition is judge under Table A – not Against the Clock to be qualified to the 2 nd day.
	The finals for Children, comprise two competitions, each taking place on a different day.
	Athletes eliminated or retired from any round will not continue to the next round.
DAY 2	The starting order of all participants will be a reverse order base on the penalties and time incurred in the first day competition.
	The jump off starting order is the same from the first round competition.
	The final competition is conducted One Round with Jump Off and the total penalties incurred over two days will count to determine the final result.

NOVICE

DAY 1	The competition is judge under Table A – Against the Clock to be qualified to the 2 nd day.
	The finals for Novice, comprise two competitions, each taking place on a different day.
	Athletes eliminated or retired from any round will not continue to the next round.
	Best 30 athletes will go to the 2 nd day.
DAY 2	The starting order of All participants will be as a reverse order of penalties and time incurred in the first day competitions.
	The jump off starting order is the same from the first round competition.
	The final competition is conducted One Round with Jump Off and the total penalties incurred over two days will count to determine the final result.

DIVISION 2

DAY 1	The competition is judge under Table A – not Against the Clock to be qualified to the 2 nd day.
	The finals for Division 2, comprise two competitions, each taking place on a different day.
	Best 25 athletes qualified for the 2 nd day. If there is equality for 25th place between athletes, then they will all qualify to the second day.
	Athletes eliminated or retired from any round will not continue to the next round.
	Best 25 athletes qualified for the 2 nd day.
DAY 2	The starting order of all participants will be a reverse order base on the penalties and time incurred in the first day competition.
	2 nd Round starting order is in reverse order of accumulated penalties.
	The final competition for (Division 2), will be conducted Table A Over Two Rounds – 1 st round not Against the Clock and 2 nd round Against the Clock to determine the winner.

	The final competition for (Junior/Young Rider), will be conducted Table A Over Two Rounds – 1 st round not Against the Clock and 2 nd round Against the Clock to determine the winner.

	Athletes eliminated or retired from any round will not continue to the next round.
DAY 2	The competition is judge under Table A – not Against the Clock.
	The starting order of all participants will be a reverse order base on the penalties and time incurred in the first day competition.
DAY 3	The starting order of all participants will be a reverse order base on accumulated penalties and time incurred in the 2 nd day competition.
	2 nd Round starting order is in reverse order of accumulated penalties and time of the first round.
	The final competition for (Division 1), will be conducted Table A Over Two Rounds – 1 st round not Against the Clock and 2 nd round Against the Clock to determine the winner.

9. For Prize Money distribution, if 10 athletes or less there will be 6 placings, if 11-19 athletes there will be 8 placings and if 20 or more starters there will be 12 placings.

10. Show will be run according to the FEI rules and UAE-ERF Jumping National Season Regulations. All Athletes should wear their proper riding clothes when they walk the course under the FEI Jumping Rules Article 256.1.1.2.

11. No changes in starting order, any deviation due to unforeseen conditions requires NF approval. Athletes should leave the club after their class is done.

12. Actual prize money distributed for each class will depend on number of starters and confirmed on the day of the event.

13. Stable are open on Thursday 27 April 2023 at 2 – 9PM. Stables will be allocated by the organizer. Any additional information on stabling please contact events@serc.ae and any cancellation of entries. Horses arrival is maximum 10pm.
