**Subject: Horse Health Requirements – 1 January 2022**

In accordance with the FEI Veterinary Regulations 2022, the Horse Health Requirements are being put in place as of 1<sup>st</sup> January 2022.

Accordingly, all horses competing at the FEI events, worldwide, must fulfill the Horse Health Requirements via Horse App.

It is compulsory for the FEI Veterinarians, Athletes, Grooms, Owners, Trainers also have to use the Horse App, the purpose is explained in the links below:

In this regard, the FEI has sent us the Newsletter detailing the need and procedure involved in the use of the Horse App which is self-explanatory.

Following the [FEI Update](#) sent on 10 December 2021, we would like to provide you with some further information on the [Horse Health Requirements](#) and your specific role.

As you are aware, the Examination at Arrival is compulsory for all FEI Events in accordance with Art. 1031 of the [FEI Veterinary Regulations](#).

It is the responsibility of the Veterinary Delegate/President of the Vet Commission to organise and coordinate the Examination at Arrival process, as well as ensuring all biosecurity measures are in place and respected.

In accordance with Art. 1029 and 1031 of the FEI 2022 Veterinary Regulations, as of 1 January 2022, ALL Horses competing at ALL FEI Events worldwide must fulfil the Horse Health Requirements via the FEI HorseApp.

As FEI Veterinarians, it is also compulsory to use the [FEI HorseApp](#) whilst performing the Examination at Arrival.

Whilst performing the [Examination at Arrival with the FEI HorseApp](#):

- You will be able to see if the PR has filled in the require three days of temperature recordings prior to arrival
- You will be able to see if the PR has filled in the required Self-Certification Form
- You will need to enter the rectal temperature of the Horse which is taken by the PR/Groom during the Examination at Arrival

It is possible to connect your Bluetooth microchip reader to the FEI HorseApp to assist with identification and to facilitate the process of entering the Examination at Arrival information in the FEI HorseApp.
